

How to make up a Christmas box

1. Get a wrapped shoebox

Each shoebox should have a lid.

2. Choose some items to put in the box

You'll need to decide who to make the box for: A girl or a boy?
How old: 4-6 years old or 7-10 years old? Think about the person you are making the box for as you choose what to put in it.

- First you need fun things (only take one or two things to begin with): small toys, sweets, balls, colouring or sticker books, loom kits
- Next something practical: pens/pencils, hats, gloves, scarves
- Then something to help keep you clean: toothpaste/brush, soap, facecloth, sponge, comb

If the box looks a bit empty go and choose some more things to fill it up. Before you go on to the next stage, ask yourself *"Would I be happy to receive this box?"*

3. Get a label for the box

Tick the box on the label for the right group: Boy 4-6, Boy, 7-10
Girl 4-6 or Girl 7-10.

Tick the boxes on the label to show what items you have put in the Christmas box.

4. Secure the lid to the box with two elastic bands

Put the lid on and put the elastic bands around the box to keep everything safe. Stick the label to the lid of the box.

5. Put your box with the other completed boxes. Well done! Do you have time to make another one..?
